2. What Rapid City lake has a gazebo?

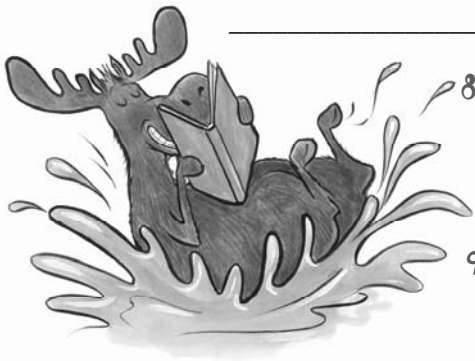
3. What area in Custer State Park has been designated as a natural area named after a creek and a walk in fishing area connected to a president that cannot be developed?

10. What kind of snack machine will you see when you walk into the only restaurant located on a golf course near the creek?

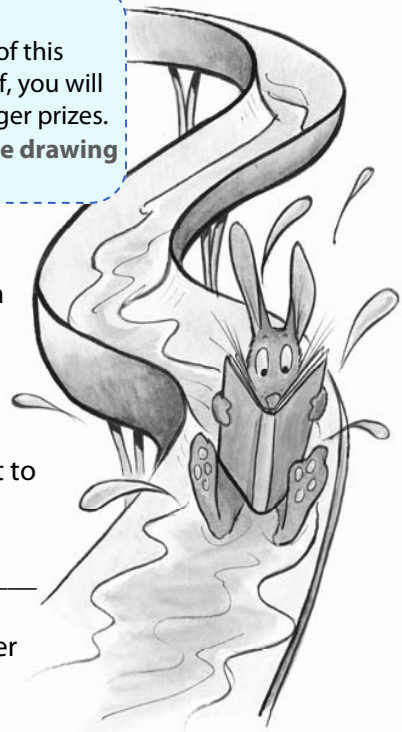
11. How many stone pebble covered stools sit next to the slide at Horace Mann Swimming Pool?
