(WASHINGTON)---SENATOR GEORGE MCGOVERN IS URGING PRESIDENT
NIXON TO ESTABLISH WHAT MCGOVERN CALLED A "BLACK HILLS REHABILITATION
COMMISSION."

MCGOVERN SAID THE COMMISSION COULD DEAL WITH THE SPECIAL
PERSONAL AND BUSINESS PROBLEMS THAT RESULTED FROM THE FLOODING
IN RAPID CITY AND AT OTHER SITES IN THE AREA .

HE URGED THE PRESIDENT TO TAKE THE ACTION BY EXECUTIVE ORDER
AND SET UP A COMMISSION SIMILAR TO THE ALASKA REHABILITATION
COMMISSION. THAT COMMISSION WAS ESTABLISHED FOLLOWING THE ALASKAN
EARTHQUAKE AND HELPED RESTORE THE ECONOMY OF THE STATE .

THE SOUTH DAKOTA DEMOCRAT SAID THE SITUATION COULD BE HANDLED
THROUGH THE REGULAR PROCESSES OF CONGRESS . BUT HE SAYS THE
EMERGENCY DEMANDS OF THE SITUATION IN THE BLACK HILLS REQJIRE
IMMEDIATE ACTION BY THE PRESIDENT .

MCGOVERN SAYS THE HOMELESS AND THE BUSINESS COMMUNITY OF
SOUTH DAKOTA'S SECOND LARGES T CITY CANNOT WAIT FOR CONGRESS
TO ACT .
