Wildlife, Reservations and Renewal: Author Bruce Smith at RCPL

Rapid City, S.D. – April 25, 2011 – Author, Bruce Smith will be discussing his new book “Wildlife on the Wind: A Field biologist’s Journey and an Indian Reservation’s renewal” at the Rapid City Public Library on May 7, 2011. The presentation will begin at 1 p.m. in the Helen Hoyt room at the Downtown library and will be followed by a book signing.

Smith is a 30-year veteran wildlife manager and scientist of the U.S. Fish and Wildlife Service. Now a full-time author, his writings promote wildlife conservation and resource sustainability.

Wildlife on the Wind is the first book published about wildlife restoration on an American Indian reservation. Come and learn about this conservation achievement by the Shoshone and Arapaho people of the Wind River Indian Reservation in Wyoming.
