Archaeologist to speak about dwindling resources

Rapid City, SD – Feb 9th, 2011 – Archaeologist and Lawrence County Historical Society President Jerry Bryant will speak at the Downtown Public Library on March 3rd at 6:30 (Meeting Room B) about the dwindling historic resources in the Black Hills.

Jerry is an accomplished historian and is well known for the honors he earned for his work on the HBO series *Deadwood* which included three Emmy recognitions and the Primetime Creative Arts Emmy Award in 2007.
